Instructions

Thank you for your participation in our 100 Can Challenge. Please email us at 2can@2cents4change.com to sign up for our challenge. With your help we will stock the local food pantries with non-perishable food for Thanksgiving and beyond. Here is what you need to do:

1. Set up a collection receptacle (a large box, plastic bin or other sizable container) where your customers, students or employees can deposit their donated food items.
2. Affix a 100 Can Challenge sign to your container **and** post one or more in visible locations. (go to www.penniesforpoverty.org and click on downloads to print your signs)
3. When your container needs to be emptied you can take it to one of the local food pantries:
Salvation Army, 40 Water St, Newburyport (hours: M-Th, 12:30 to 4:30)
Community Service, 31 Green St, Newburyport (hours: M-Th, 9-2:30)
Our Neighbors Table, 145 Main St., Amesbury (hours: M-F, 9:30-2:30)
Pettengill House, 13 Lafayette Rd, Salisbury (hours: M-Th 8-4)
